Confessions are also offered at this time. * First Friday Adoration—adoration around the clock for 24 hours beginning after the 8am Mass on Friday and continuing until the 8am Mass on Saturday (except during the 7:30pm Hispanic Mass). During Lent, this would be Friday, March 2nd. * Wed., March 21st from 9am—8pm during the diocesan-wide, Be Reconciled Day (all day confessions) • <u>Lenten Soup Suppers & Stations of the Cross.</u> Beginning at 5:30pm, volunteers provide a simple Lenten meal (e.g. soup, bread). It is a way to remember our solidarity with all who pray, fast and give alms. Groups from the Parish make the dinner and host the supper. Invite your neighbors and friends. Bring the family. No donation is required. • Fridays at 6:15pm are deacon-led Stations of the Cross.
